Cleveland, January 31, 2011: Cellar Door Records will be celebrating their 6th release, "Cellar Door Records Volume III," on March 18, 2011 at the Grog Shop in Cleveland Heights. Admission price of \$10 includes a copy of the new album. Bands performing include Joshua Jesty and band, Humble Home, Rob Geer and Band, Frozen Hellsicles and moonshake.

"Cellar Door Records Volume III" is a collection of music from some of the best and brightest artists in Cleveland. Cellar Door veterans Josh Jesty, Keith Vance, Justin Markert and Doug Ivancic have contributed new material as well as a number of newcomers to our circle, but certainly not to the scene. The rock & roll of Diamonds & Pearls and The Modern Electric, the indie folk of Humble Home and Tinamou, the instrumental post-rock of moonshake, the ambient sounds of David Beans, and the songwriting of Tom Evanchuck and Rob Geer, make for an eclectic yet powerful example of what Cleveland has to offer.

Cellar Door Records is a small boutique record label run out of Cleveland Ohio.

In 2002, good friends Justin Markert and Rick Fike opened a coffee shop in small town Madison Ohio called Cellar Door Coffee & Music. The 135 capacity room served as a catalyst for the arts, an organic space taking many shapes and forms. Cellar Door booked everything from acoustic singer-songwriters to four band hardcore shows. Dozens of nationally touring bands came through Cellar Door, opening the eyes of it's clientele to a world of music they had never experienced before. We wanted tangible evidence of this creative music scene that had sprung up in rural Madison, thus Cellar Door Records was born.

Cellar Door Records Volume I had a run of 125 copies. Printed and put together by hand, the compilation contained two tracks from six of our favorite artists. A CD release show was thrown, the artists performed and the CD was given out for free. We sold the coffee shop and went back to our normal lives.

In 2007, Justin and Rick regrouped with partner Adam Butcher to officially re-launch Cellar Door Records. The label was reborn at the Beachland Ballroom on March 3, 2007, with the official release of Cellar Door Records Volume II. Since then we've released 5 full-length releases and booked many "Cellar Door Records Presents" shows. After putting out a number of individual artist's albums, we're returning to form with the release of Cellar Door Records Volume III.
